**PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION: PROGRAM STANDARD 25**

Private passenger cars and vans may be used during Girl Scout activities. They must be properly registered, insured, and operated by adults with a valid license for the type and size of vehicle used. Any other form of private transportation may be used only after council approval has been obtained.

The number of passengers in the vehicle does not exceed the intended passenger limits. Each person has her or his own seat and is buckled into a seat belt. Vehicles are used for their intended purpose. Trucks and similar vehicles used to transport equipment and supplies are not used to transport anyone in the area designed for cargo. Trailers or other towed vehicles are not used to transport passengers. Vehicles designed to serve as recreational homes are used to transport only the number of persons for which there are specifically designed passenger seats and seat belts. All vehicles are equipped with a first-aid kit and any federal or state required safety equipment.
