This encampment is aboard a naval ship, which is being maintained as closely as possible to her original naval service condition. In order to reach the berthing areas and tour the remainder of the vessel, campers will need to be able to negotiate ladders and pass through many watertight doors.

The minimum age for the encampment is 8 years old. There is a requirement that one adult accompany each child 8 or 9 years old, one adult for every 5 children 10 to 11 years old, and one adult for each 7 youths 12 to 18 years old. The basic one night stay-over is from 1800 hours (6PM) to 0930 hours (9.30AM) the following day, dinner and breakfast included for about of forty dollars for each attendee, child or adult.
