FIRE SAFETY PLAN  
CAMP WENDY

The Ranger (or leader, if Ranger is not available) will call the fire department.

A fire emergency shall be announced to all campers with the ringing of the gong located near the lake behind Martin Lodge (main camp area). The gong will ring until all campers are assembled and accounted for. The following code indicates the area of danger:

- 1 ring - Greenwood/Tinker Bell
- 2 rings - Pioneer
- 3 rings - Romany
- 4 rings - Jungle
- 5 rings - Main Camp
- Continuous rings - Evacuate Camp

\* If the emergency is located in main camp, the designated safe area is the field behind Jungle. (Jungle is located across the lake from main camp.) Always look for natural firebreak and get on opposite side of fire or work your way around so fire is blowing away from you.

Troop Camp Units: Have each girl get a towel if accessible and line up at unit kitchen. Leader in charge takes head count (including adults) and leads campers to safety, one leader in front and one leader in back of line.

All adults not in units: Lead campers who are under their supervision to safety.

Stay calm and do constant head checks. Be deliberate in giving directions. Assemble at flag pole. Check number of people and report to Camp Director or Ranger. Wait until further advised or all clear bell is sounded.

INTERNAL FIRE FIGHTING

Always have equipment handy to fight fires. Use running water in each unit. Keep buckets, brooms and rakes by each fire place.
